Instructions for Customers:

- 1) Bring in two incandescent bulbs from your home. (For maximum energy savings the two most commonly used light bulbs will save you the most money)
- 2) Put your bulbs in the hole in the top of the clear bin (these bulbs are obsolete now, and will soon not be sold in Canada)
- 3) Grab a 2-pack of compact fluorescent bulbs and take them to the counter
- 4) Ask the cashier for the sign up sheet and print and sign your name and address
- 5) Only two bulbs available per household
- 6) Make the Switch will run from February 4th to the 15th or until all of the light bulbs are gone.
