


Caribou Harvesting Regulation Changes in North and South Slave Regions



Harvesters in the Northwest Territories are advised that the following hunting regulation changes are effective January 1, 2010.

- Barren-ground caribou commercial (meat tag), non-resident and resident harvest is closed in the North and South Slave regions.
- A no-hunting conservation zone, applying to all harvesters, has been established north of Yellowknife where the Bathurst caribou herd winters (see map above).

These regulations remain in effect until recommendations from the Wek'eezhii Renewable Resources Board are implemented.
