

## 10 Commandments of Firearms Safety

- 1. Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.
- 2. Always control the muzzle of your firearm.
- 3. Be sure of your target and beyond.
- 4. Never shoot at a flat, hard surface including water.
- 5. Never point a firearm at anything you don't want to shoot.
- 6. Never climb, run or jump with a loaded firearm.
- 7. Lock up firearms and ammunition separately.
- 8. Be sure the barrel is clear of obstructions.
- 9. Unload firearms when not in use.
- 10. Avoid alcohol before and during a hunt.

Remember, you need a firearms possession-only licence or a firearms possession and acquisition licence.
