

10 Commandments of Firearms Safety

1. Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.
2. Always control the muzzle of your firearm.
3. Be sure of your target and beyond.
4. Never shoot at a flat, hard surface including water.
5. Never point a firearm at anything you don't want to shoot.
6. Never climb, run or jump with a loaded firearm.
7. Lock up firearms and ammunition separately.
8. Be sure the barrel is clear of obstructions.
9. Unload firearms when not in use.
10. Avoid alcohol before and during a hunt.

Remember, you need a firearms possession-only licence or a firearms possession and acquisition licence.
