

GNWT Direct Deposit Payment Service

The Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) provides Direct Deposit service to have GNWT payments deposited to Canadian bank accounts of businesses, government entities, individuals, organizations and students.

The following list shows examples of individuals, businesses and other entities that can have funds deposited directly to their bank accounts:

- Employees who receive non-salary payments; such as, travel advances, travel expense reimbursements, professional dues reimbursements, etc;
- Students who receive financial assistance;
- Businesses and individuals who receive payments; such as, vendor payments and grants or contribution; and
- Other entities (Boards, Agencies, Associations, Community Governments) that receive grants or contributions.

Benefits of Direct Deposit include:

- Elimination of delivery disruptions or lost mailings;
- Elimination of time spent depositing and checking payments; and
- Quicker access to funds in your bank account on the due date.

Notification of payment may be received via mail, facsimile or email and will include the same information provided on a cheque stub.
