What is the NWT Environmental Audit?

The NWT Environmental Audit checks to see how well our northern regulatory system is working to protect the environment. It can identify both successes and challenges. A key role of the Audit is to make recommendations that will improve how the environment is managed.

In the NWT, an environmental audit must be completed every five years by law. It is conducted by an independent auditor. Its main purpose is to check that our system of integrated land and water management is protecting the environment. It also makes suggestions for improvement.

The auditor for the upcoming 2020 Audit is the *NWT Environmental Audit Team*, a Joint Venture of practitioners who either live or have worked extensively in the NWT. They will be collecting information and views from a wide range of sources, including people involved in land and water management as well as the public. ***Please get involved!***
